Topic 5: Baserunning Part I (Due: March 1)
Answer each with True or False.
1. Bases loaded and 2 outs. The runner from third base scored on a passed ball (uncaught third strike) before the batter-runner was thrown out at first base. The run scores.
2. A runner who is awarded a walk — including an intentional walk — can overrun first base without liability to be put out.
3. A run cannot score if the third out is a force out.
4. If two runners occupy the same base at the same time and there is a force situation, the lead runner will be called out.
5. It is a one base award if an outfielder throws a batted ball out of play.
6. A runner leaves his base too soon on a caught fly ball and there are two outs. After a proper appeal is made, he is called out. Any runs scored prior to the appeal would not count.
7. When the first throw by an infielder becomes dead, the award is two bases from the base occupied at the time the ball became dead.
8. It is a three-base award if a thrown ball is touched by detached player equipment.
9. If a player catches a ball and his momentum carries him into dead ball territory, the runners would be awarded two bases.
10. R1 is on 2nd. The catcher obstructs B3, but B3 hits the ball and reaches first base safely. R1, who was not moving on the pitch, is thrown out at home plate. The umpire allows the out at the plate to stand.
